



Purpose of the grant

To improve the provision of P.E. and sport in school so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles.

Basis of the allocation

Allocations are calculated on:

- Based on the January 2015 census
- Schools with 16 or fewer eligible pupils receive £500 per pupil.
- Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £8,000 and an additional payment of £5 per pupil.

The grant must be made available irrespective of the existence of any deficit relating to the expenditure of the school's budget share. PE and Sport Grant is not part of the school's budget shares and is not part of the individual school's budget.

Schools receive PE and sport premium funding based on the number of pupils in years 1 to 6.

Lea Valley Primary School Allocation

PE and Sport 2015/2016: £8,000 + £5 x 360 pupils in Years 1-6 = £9,800
